

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION MINOR

UW-Superior education programs are approved by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (<https://dpi.wi.gov/>) to fulfill specific licensure requirements for the state of Wisconsin at the time of degree completion. Some requirements may unavoidably change as state requirements change; students should stay in close communication with their advisors throughout your program. If students seek licensure in a state other than Wisconsin, they should review the UW-Superior Institutional Certification Office (<https://www.uwsuper.edu/frequently-asked-questions/institutional-certification-office-faqs/>) web page for further information and assistance.

This minor is intended to be paired with an eligible DPI-approved licensure area offered at UW-Superior. B-Grade 3 Elementary Education Majors-Early Childhood Concentration must complete this minor to be eligible for the Wisconsin B-Grade 3 license. This minor may also be paired with the K-9 Elementary Education Major and the Instruction Minor as an additional minor. This license also requires a passing score on the approved pedagogical knowledge assessment, the Wisconsin Foundations of Reading Test, and student teaching. A minimum grade of C is required for all courses.
