

INSTRUCTION MINOR

UW-Superior education programs are approved by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (<http://dpi.wi.gov/>) to fulfill licensure requirements for the state of Wisconsin. This minor is intended to be paired with an eligible DPI-approved licensure area offered at UW-Superior. K-9 Elementary Education majors must complete this minor to be eligible for the Wisconsin K-9 teaching license. Student teaching and all other licensure requirements must also be successfully completed. This minor is not available to non-education majors. A grade of C is required for all courses in this minor (except for B requirements in T ED 200 Introduction to Education and the pass requirement in T ED 100 Orientation to Teacher Education.)
