

# SPECIAL EDUCATION MINOR

This array of courses must be taken in conjunction with the Elementary Education Major and the Instruction Minor to be eligible for a Wisconsin K-12 Special Education license. This license also requires a passing score on the approved pedagogical knowledge assessment, the Wisconsin Foundations of Reading Test, and a grade of C must be earned in all major and minor courses (except for B requirements in T ED 200 Introduction to Education and the pass requirement in T ED 100 Orientation to Teacher Education).

UW-Superior education programs are approved by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (<http://dpi.wi.gov/>) to fulfill specific licensure requirements for the state of Wisconsin at the time of degree completion. Some requirements may unavoidably change as state requirements change; students should stay in close communication with their advisors throughout your program.
